One of our key objectives with the Matching Grant Fund is not only to build capacity and facilitate access to finance but also to support compliance with new EU legislation, such as regulations on deforestation and corporate sustainability due diligence. These regulations are crucial for environmental protection and ensuring smooth trade relations, and our interventions aim to prepare our member states to meet these standards.

Furthermore, synergy building is essential. We aim to harmonize efforts between OACPS and EU programs in private sector development to maximize resources and impact. We encourage active participation from all stakeholders to ensure that the Matching Grant Fund achieves its intended outcomes, especially in empowering the missing middle and fostering sustainable impact.

In conclusion, I echo the points already raised: we are here to support you through this launch and readiness program. Your active engagement, questions, and clarifications are crucial as we strive for a Matching Grant Fund that truly makes a difference.
